# ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- University of Ghana Diploma
- Diploma/HND Holders from accredited tertiary institutions
- WASSCE/SSSCE Holders

## i) APPLICANTS IN POSSESSION OF UNIVERSITY OF GHANA DIPLOMAS

Holders of University of Ghana Diplomas, with a Final Grade Point Average

(FGPA) of 3.00 or better are eligible to apply and where required, supported with two other subjects in a related field, for admission. In addition, such applicants MUST have:

- WASSCE/SSSCE passes with **CREDIT** (at least C6/D) in three (3) Core subjects and two (2) electives or
- credit passes in five subjects including English Language, Science and Mathematics at the GCE 'O' Level, as well as passes in two subjects at the GCE 'A' Level.

All University of Ghana Diploma holders will be admitted to Level 200, irrespective of the subject area of their diploma qualification.

### ii) APPLICANTS IN POSSESSION OF DIPLOMAS/HIGHER NATIONAL DIPLOMAS (HND) FROM *OTHER* ACCREDITED TERTIARY INSTITUTIONS

Holders of Diplomas and Higher National Diplomas (HND) from other accredited tertiary Institutions with a **Final Grade Point Average (FGPA) of 3.25** or better are eligible to apply to the **SAME** area of study, and where required, supported with one other subject in a related field, for admission. **In addition,** such applicants **MUST** have:

- WASSCE/SSSCE passes with **CREDIT** (at least C6/D) in three (3) Core subjects and two (2) electives in the appropriate subjects or
- credit passes in five subjects including English Language, Science and Mathematics at the GCE 'O' Level, as well as passes in two subjects at the GCE 'A' Level.

All Diploma and HND holders from other accredited tertiary Institutions will be admitted to Level 200 in the **SAME SUBJECT AREA** as their HND/Diploma qualification.

## iii) WASSCE/SSSCE APPLICANTS

Senior High School graduates must possess:

At least credits (A1 - C6 in WASSCE and A – D in SSSCE) in English, Core Mathematics and Integrated Science (for Science applicants) and Social Studies

(for non-Science applicants) and three elective subjects in General Arts/Business, with the total aggregate not exceeding 24.

Applicants for Economics must have at least credit (A1-C6) in Elective Mathematics
